**Subject:** Principale E sidewalk and School start

### Good morning Alisa,

Pursuant to a concern raised yesterday afternoon regarding school start, I had meetings with both the principal of Ste-Marguerite d'Youville Mme Julie Lachance and the contractor Mr. Dan Labelle. In order to ensure pubic and worker safety, the contractor will ensure an adequate compacted gravel walkway will be in place for pedestrians prior to the first day of school. The contractor has also assured me that construction will be minimal to nil during the hours of school start (0815-0900 approximately) and school end (1500-1545 approximately) for the remainder of the project.

The contractor is scheduled to form and pour the new concrete sidewalk during the second or third week of September and Mr. Labelle has assured me that public/worker safety will be paramount. The students/pedestrians will have adequate space to walk on the wide shoulder of Principale E without having to close the road according to the contractor. The contractor also brought up some re assurance by stating that the Michaud St. project of last year went very well even with sidewalk construction taking place after school had started at both Northern Secondary and Ecole St-Joseph.

I have include the contractor and Mme Julie Lachance in this email for their feedback or comments at anytime during the remainder of the construction. Should conditions change, we have alternate routes and/or detours available as additional options.

It was agreed by all parties that student/pedestrian and worker safety is our primary focus on all projects and the intention is to be as least disruptive to everyone affected.

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF WEST NIPISSING CONCERNING THE USE OF ENGLISH AND FRENCH IN CARRYING ON THE PROGRAMS AND WORK OF THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF WEST NIPISSING

WHEREAS the Corporation of the Municipality of West Nipissing celebrates the bilingual nature of the Municipality of West Nipissing and deems it essential to establish a policy for the use of French and English for the departments and agencies of the Corporation,

AND WHEREAS Section 103 subsection (5) of the Municipal Act R.S.O. 1990 provides authority for Council to pass a by-law governing the use of French and English when conducting the business and affairs of the Municipality by officers and employees,

AND WHEREAS Section 14, subsection (1) Chapter F.32 of the French Language Services Act, R.S.O. 1990 as amended from time to time, states that "The Council of a new municipality may pass a by-law providing that the administration of the municipality shall be conducted in both French and English and that all or specified services to the public shall be made available in both languages";

AND WHEREAS both the Francophone and Anglophone communities have contributed and continue to contribute to the richness in the Municipality of West Nipissing;

**AND WHEREAS** the Municipality of West Nipissing wishes to ensure an equal treatment to all its Francophone and Anglophone residents;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF WEST NIPISSING ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

### 1. **RECOGNITION:**

The Corporation of the Municipality of West Nipissing celebrates the bilingual nature of the Municipality of West Nipissing and requires the departments and agencies of the Corporation being able to provide services to and communication with the public in both the official languages of French and English.

### 2. GOALS:

- 2.1 To ensure an equal treatment to all Francophone and Anglophone residents in the Municipality of West Nipissing;
- 2.2 To provide the opportunity to the residents of West Nipissing of choosing the official language in which they wish to be served.
- 2.3 To permit a municipal employee to be able to work in his or her own language and to create an atmosphere which encourages the use of both official languages; to provide bilingual services to the public based on the following objectives:

### 3. OBJECTIVES

- 3.1 To provide for the staffing by bilingual persons, fluent in both languages of French and English, where designated.
- 3.2 To giving priority to those competent in carrying out the municipal policy on bilingualism, when hiring personnel.

- 3.3 To produce, in both official languages, the logo, corporate identity, public signs and any public information material offered to the general public.
- 3.4 To reply to any correspondence received in either language in the language of the official enquiry.
- 3.5 To encourage its employees to take language courses in order to improve their ability to communicate in both official languages.
- 3.6 To guarantee the present rights and privileges of uni-lingual employees.

WATER LEVELS ON STURGEON RIVER AND COMMUNICATION

We would like to inform Council of the communication protocol in place regarding planned and unplanned events that impact water levels on the Upper Sturgeon River and West Nipissing Power Generation.

If there are planned maintenance events scheduled at the power plant or at the dams upstream, advance notice will be provided to our communications staff and clerical staff. We will issue public notices in advance of these events and front line staff will be able to answer calls and questions coming in regarding water levels on the river.

When unplanned events happen, these are typically emergency situations. The manager of the power plant will notify municipal administration staff as soon as it is reasonably possible, understanding that emergency response and containment is a priority. We will advise the public via our various social media accounts and website and be able to respond to inquires received.

WHEREAS Section 31 (2) of the *Municipal Act 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25*, as amended, requires a municipality by by-law to establish a highway for public use.


