D-1) GENERAL GOVERNMENT / GOUVERNEMENT GÉNÉRAL

D-1(a) Website – Overview of new format

Communications staff, Kim Cuillerier and Kassandre Jolin provided an overview of the new municipal website, providing highlights of the features and enhancements including a number of new interactive modules such as Service Requests and Recycle Coach. Council members expressed approval of the new website and the enhanced features.

D-1(b) Request for tax levy by WNGH for operation of CT Scanner

The Director of Corporate Services provided an analysis of the request by the West Nipissing General Hospital for the imposition of a levy to assist in the staffing of the new CT Scanner recently installed. The Director explained how the levy would be applied. Council was generally in agreement that the matter be further discussed in the course of budget deliberations. Some members expressed concern regarding the possibility of setting precedent and discussions regarding how the levy be distributed ie: vacant land, commercial property, etc. The Treasurer was directed to come back to Council with the legal mechanics of imposing such a levy, all to be discussed at budget time.

D-1(c) Discussion re: 2021 Budget Process

Council discussed the Budget process to be undertaken for the 2021 year. The CAO provided a memo setting out a proposed framework for budget deliberations. Following discussions, members were not in agreement to move forward without 2020 actual numbers which will move the process start to mid to late February. Staff will send out proposed dates for consideration.
