

BY-LAW 2024/34**A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 2015/42
TO PROVIDE FOR THE CIVIC ADDRESS NUMBERING SYSTEM OF CERTAIN BUILDINGS AND LOTS
IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF WEST NIPISSING**

WHEREAS Section 10(1) of *the Act* provides the authority for a Municipality to provide any services or thing that the municipality considers necessary or desirable for the public; and

WHEREAS Section 10(2)(6) of *the Act* provides the authority for a Municipality to pass by-laws regarding the health, safety well-being of persons; and

WHEREAS highways as defined in Section 26 of *the Act* are under the jurisdiction of a municipality; and

WHEREAS Section 27 of *the Act* provides the authority for a municipality to pass by-laws in respect of the highways within its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS the Municipality of West Nipissing has adopted By-Law 2015-42 to provide for the civic addressing of buildings and lots in the municipality of West Nipissing and in accordance with Section 116(1) of *the Act* which permits a municipality to establish, maintain and operate a centralized communication response system for emergency response purposes; and

AND WHEREAS “Farm 911 – Emily Numbers” have been established to provide civic addresses for farm fields and agricultural properties which would not otherwise qualify for a civic address and where emergencies may occur in order to facilitate emergency response;

AND WHEREAS the Municipality of West Nipissing has a large agricultural community and Council for the Municipality of West Nipissing wishes to ensure the continued safety of farmers, their families and employees by amending By-Law 2015-42 to include Farm 911 addressing;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL FOR THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF WEST NIPISSING ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Schedule “A” Civic Addressing” is hereby amended as follows:

Farm 911 – Emily Numbers

3.21 A Rural farm property may request a civic address for field entrances and agricultural properties which may not otherwise qualify for a civic address (ie working fields with no structures, secondary fields entrances or field entrances fronting on different roads than the primary address of the property)

- 3.22 A farm property is eligible for an Emily Number where there is
- (a) an existing primary entrance on an existing field;
 - (b) a secondary entrance on a farm field;
 - (c) a secondary entrance on a property with non-residential work activity other than agricultural;

3.23 Entrances for Emily Numbers may be inspected prior to installation, however there will be no requirement to improve an existing field entrance to the municipal standard unless deemed necessary through inspection. An entrance permit that meets municipal standards will be required for new field entrances only.

7.6 **Guidelines for Farm 911-Emily Signs**

- 7.6.1 Emily signs shall be installed in accordance with the provisions of 7.1 of this By-Law, save and except for 7.1.5. Emily sign blades shall be Yellow with black numbering;
